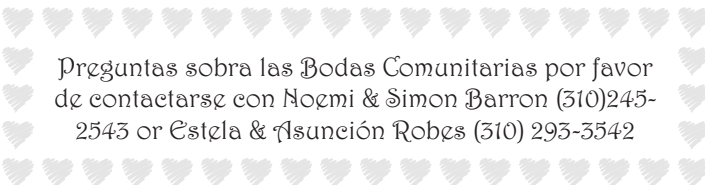
**ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
