

#### FROM THE PASTOR

BACK TO THE "GREEN SUNDAYS" – Now that the Easter Season has been completed with the celebration of Pentecost three weeks ago and having celebrated the beautiful feasts of the Most Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi, we return to the "green Sundays" of Ordinary Time. As you know, Ordinary Time is divided in two parts: the first is the portion of the season following the completion of the Christmas season and prior to Lent. The second, longer period, is that which follows the Easter season and continues throughout the summer and early Fall and concludes just prior to Advent. We have now entered into that second portion of the season of Ordinary Time.

The term "Ordinary Time" may be misleading. In the context of the liturgical year the term "ordinary" does not mean "usual or average." Ordinary here means "not seasonal." Ordinary Time is that part of the Liturgical Year that lies outside the seasons of Lent-Easter and Advent-Christmas. In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its aspects. The readings during the liturgies of Ordinary Time help to instruct us on how to live out our Christian faith in our daily lives. The liturgical color of Ordinary Time is green which is a symbol for hope and growth.

You are invited to a special concelebrated Mass at 10:00am to give thanks to God for our many gifts and to pray for the United States of America and its people.

A reminder that there is only one scheduled Mass at 10:00am on the following holidays: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day. On these four holidays the <u>church and parking lot will be opened around 9:00am and closed shortly after the Mass</u>. These are beautiful days to celebrate the Eucharist and pray for our country.

MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP FIRST WEDNESDAY MASS THIS WEEK –The Novena in honor of Our Mother of Perpetual Help is prayed each Wednesday at 6:30 pm. For the present time we have added the celebration of the Mass after the novena prayers on the First Wednesday of the month. These dates include the following: June 5, July 3, August 7, September 4, etc.

**FIRST FRIDAY MASSES THIS WEEK** – On the First Friday of each month we have the usual weekday 6:30am

and 8:00am Masses in English in the morning and we add a bilingual Mass at 7:00pm. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar after the evening Mass until 10:00pm. The first hour is a silent Holy Hour followed by reflections and prayers in Spanish beginning at 9:00pm. Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament takes place about 9:50pm.

# A PRAYER FOR AMERICA BY JOHN CARROLL, FIRST U.S. BISHOP By Gretchen Filz

Pope Pius VI named John Carroll the first bishop of the United States of America in 1789. His cousin, Charles Carroll, was one of America's Founding Fathers and the only Catholic to sign the Declaration of Independence.

Bishop John Carroll would go on to become America's first archbishop when the Diocese of Baltimore, Maryland--- the mother diocese of the United States---was elevated to the status of archdiocese.

Archbishop Carroll was also the founder of America's first Catholic university---Georgetown. These interesting facts are a testament that Catholics played a significant role in the founding of our nation.

Archbishop Carroll wrote the following prayer for our newly formed government on November 10, 1791, to be recited in parishes throughout his diocese. The text of the prayer below is taken from EWTN's *National Catholic Register*.

It is an excellent prayer especially for the times we live in now, over 200 years later, to remind us of the crucial role faith and prayer has always played in our nation since its beginning. Also each year on July 4th, Independence Day, we can especially pray for our government as we are commanded to do in Sacred Scripture:

I desire therefore, first of all, that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all men: For kings, and for all that are in high station: that we may lead a quiet and a peaceable life in all piety and chastity. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, Who will have all men to be saved, and to come to the knowledge of the truth. (1 Timothy 2 1-4)

PRAYER FOR OUR GOVERNMENT BY ARCHBISHOP JOHN CARROLL (1791) We pray, O almighty and eternal God, who through Jesus Christ has revealed thy

glory to all nations, to preserve the works of your mercy, that your Church, being spread through the whole world, may continue with unchanging faith in the confession of your name.

We pray Thee, who alone are good and holy, to endow with heavenly knowledge, sincere zeal and sanctity of life, our chief bishop, the pope, the vicar of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the government of his Church; our own bishop, all other bishops, prelates and pastors of the Church; and especially those who are appointed to exercise among us the functions of the holy ministry, and conduct your people into the ways of salvation.

We pray O God of might, wisdom and justice, through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with your Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude the president of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness and be eminently useful to your people over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality.

Let the light of your divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our rule and government, so that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety and useful knowledge; and may perpetuate to us the blessing of equal liberty.

We pray for his excellency, the governor of this state, for the members of the assembly, for all judges, magistrates, and other officers who are appointed to guard our political welfare, that they may be enabled, by your powerful protection, to discharge the duties of their respective stations with honesty and ability.

We recommend likewise, to your unbounded mercy, all our brethren and fellow citizens throughout the United States, that they may be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the observance of your most holy law; that they may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal.

Finally, we pray to you, O Lord of mercy, to remember the souls of your servants departed, who are gone before us with the sign of faith and repose in the sleep of peace; the souls of our parents, relatives and friends; of those who, when living, were members of this congregation, and particularly of such as are lately deceased; of all benefactors who, by their donations or legacies to this Church, witnessed their zeal for the decency of divine worship and proved their claim to our grateful and charitable remembrance. To these, O Lord, and to all that rest in Christ, grant, we beseech you, a place of refreshment, light and everlasting peace, through the same Jesus Christ, Our Lord and Savior. Amen.


